



Preparing to Vacate Your Home in a Wildfire

Preparation for a possible wildfire starts **long before an evacuation order** — through home hardening and brush-removal efforts undertaken well in advance. A wealth of guidance is available online, including on the **Glenwild HOA Member Portal** (www.glenwild.com). Firefighting experts describe evacuation preparation in three phases: **Ready, Set, Go**.

READY

LONG BEFORE A FIRE

Harden your home and clear brush from around the property — most homes ignite from **wind-blown embers**, not the fire front itself.

PREPARE YOUR “GO LIST” NOW

Medicines · electronic devices · important papers · pets & supplies. Preparing it in advance makes for a thoughtful, organized evacuation.

SET

FIRE IN THE AREA — BE ALERT

- Confirm your phones are registered in the alert systems described below.
- Track nearby fire growth in real time on the **Watch Duty** app.
- Stage your Go List items, vehicle, and pets so you can leave quickly.
- Consider whether a neighbor might need your assistance.

GO

LEAVING YOUR HOME

- If time permits: **close all windows and doors** as you exit.
- Move flammable objects (door mats, cushions, firewood) away from the house.
- Once safely out, **let loved ones know you are safe**.
- Check on neighbors who may need help.

SUMMIT COUNTY EMERGENCY ALERTS

The county's Emergency Alert Program sends evacuation and wildfire notices by text, call, and email. Enroll at summitready.org.

WATCH DUTY APP (FREE)

Real-time wildfire mapping and alerts, verified by a team of real people — first responders, dispatchers, and retired firefighters monitoring emergency radio and official sources.

KNOW YOUR EXITS

Depending on the direction of an approaching fire, choose the optimal route out of Glenwild.

PRIMARY ENTRANCES / EXITS

- **Main Gate**
- **East Gate**

Use whichever gate leads away from the approaching fire.

EMERGENCY EXIT PATHS (LOCKED)

- **Fire road** at the top of Snow Berry
- **Exit gate** into The Preserve
- **Knob Hill gate**
